

Day-Signs is Back in Print!

Bruce Scofield's book, *Day-Signs: Native American Astrology From Ancient Mexico*, which has been out-of-print for a decade is now being published by The Wessex Astrologer Ltd, a publishing company from England that publishes many high-quality books on astrology.

This new publication is also a new edition. There are some content and organization changes in the introductory chapters, the listings of people born under each of the day-signs has been expanded, the day-sign lookup tables now go to 2029, and a few minor errors here and there have been corrected. The original delineations of the 20 day-signs remain as the heart of the book, these being the most coherent, the first ever to be described in psychological terms, and the only ones produced by the methodical analysis of over 400 examples. When these delineations were first published, they presented a side of Mesoamerican astrology that was much deeper than anything previous published. Other authors began to plagiarize them, often stripping multiple sentences from the book and not giving credit.

For people who wish to develop a solid understanding of the day-signs, which are the foundation of Mesoamerican astrology, or participate in the effort to take our understanding of this astrological system further, this book is indispensable.
